We, Nera, Weesp, The Netherlands, herewith declare the following:

The definition of a biocidal product in the Biocidal Products Regulation is as follows:

## **Article 3**

## **Definitions**

- 1. For the purposes of this Regulation, the following definitions shall apply:
  - (a) 'biocidal product' means
    - any substance or mixture, in the form in which it is supplied to the user, consisting
      of, containing or generating one or more active substances, with the intention of
      destroying, deterring, rendering harmless, preventing the action of, or otherwise
      exerting a controlling effect on, any harmful organism by any means other than
      mere physical or mechanical action,
    - any substance or mixture, generated from substances or mixtures which do not themselves fall under the first indent, to be used with the intention of destroying, deterring, rendering harmless, preventing the action of, or otherwise exerting a controlling effect on, any harmful organism by any means other than mere physical or mechanical action.
    - A treated article that has a primary biocidal function shall be considered a biocidal product.

[...]

(I) 'treated article' means any substance, mixture or article which has been treated with, or intentionally incorporates, one or more biocidal products;

At this moment, Nera does not supply biocidal products for use in leather tanning.
